Ellen commented that in preparing the agenda and executive motion, she is following the advice of town counsel in protecting the interest of the town of Wayland. Donna referred to the specificity of the agenda matter noted in the February 6, 2014 agenda. Ellen confirmed that town counsel advised that the way in which the agenda item is noted is appropriate. A discussion ensued in terms of specificity and clarity related to the Open Meeting Law and town counsel's advice. The other Committee members agreed with Ellen's decision to follow the advice of town counsel.
